Student Information:

- Year 12 HSC Trial Examinations 2020 commence on **Wednesday Week 6B 26th August 2020** and conclude on **Friday Week 7A 4th September 2020**.
- There will be **No Lessons** during the examination period except for the periods when you have an examination.
- Examinations are held in the designated rooms on timetable, please read this carefully and ensure you are at the correct room for the correct exam.
- Be at the examination venue at least 20 minutes before the scheduled examination starting time.
- Students will not be permitted in to the examination 30 minutes after the exam has commenced.
- Before you commence your exam, please complete your Examination Attendance Slip which will be placed on your desk.
- Complete **SILENCE** is to be observed in the examination rooms at all times, no turning around or disruptive behaviour (please see below).
- There will be times where examinations for multiple subjects are held. Ensure you are doing the correct papers. If the examination for your subject concludes early, you must leave the examination room with extra caution to avoid disturbance to other students who are still doing their exams.
- Bring **ALL** your own equipment (including erasers, pencil sharpeners, and spare pens and pencils) for each exam. There will be no borrowing of any equipment. Only approved calculators are to be used. All your equipment must be in a clear plastic sleeve. - **Mobile Phones, Ear Phones, Smart Watches are TO BE SWITCHED OFF and left in your BAG. If you are caught with any of the above equipment during the exam it will be considered cheating and your paper will be cancelled.**
- Leave bags where you are instructed by the examination supervisors.
- In general, students will not be allowed to go to toilet for the first and the last 30 minutes of an examination. Students who are going to toilet will need to scan their student card in the card reader when leaving the examination and scan in upon their return. Students who use the senior toilets at the end of F block will be supervised by an examination supervisor.
- Use all the available time to complete examinations. **Students will NOT be permitted to leave examinations early.**
- **NO** writing is permitted during the reading time.

- Students are to write their **FULL NAME** and **STUDENT NUMBER** on every writing booklet or answer sheet.

- Unacceptable behaviour during the examinations will be dealt with in the following way:
 - First Breach – Warning given to the student and the warning recorded on the front cover of the exam paper. Senior Executive and Faculty Head Teacher for that exam will be informed immediately. Student to be moved and isolated in the examination room where possible.
 - Second Breach – Breach recorded and student asked to leave the examination room. The Breach is recorded on the front cover of their examination paper and the examination terminated for the student. Appeals will be processed as per the Year 12 Assessment Policy

- **IF YOU ARE ABSENT FROM AN EXAMINATION FOR ANY REASON PLEASE RING THE SCHOOL ON 46480111. YOU WILL NEED TO NOTIFY YOUR COHORT DEPUTY, MRS MARLIN OR MRS KOVAC AND THE HEAD TEACH OF THE FACULTY CONCERNED.** A medical certificate is required if you are absent on the day of an examination. Permission to re-sit an examination due to absence will only be given in exceptional circumstances and in-line with the Assessment Policy, please refer page 7 of your Assessment Booklet.
