

Check –In Assessment for Year 9

Dear Parents and Carers

Year 9 students will participate in a new reading and numeracy Check-in assessment in Term 3, 2020. The assessment period will take place during the next two weeks.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor Year 9 student learning, following the period of learning from home. The online assessment consists of 40 multiple choice questions and have been scheduled to be completed during normal class time.

The Check-in assessments can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment that they would normally receive in the classroom.
