TASK DESCRIPTION / INSTRUCTIONS

Part 1 Visual Arts Process Diary 10%

Students are required to submit VAPD with all classwork completed, sheet glued in, drawings labelled and coloured and title page completed.

Part 2 Aboriginal Art 20%

The Hermannsburg Potters are a group of Western Arrarnta artists who create vibrant handmade ceramic pots that encompass collective and individually lived histories in their distinct country.

Students are required to study their artmaking practice and to submit a Hermannsburg inspired pot with a decorative story covering the pot. Students need to consider:

- The story on the pot. Include, imagery connected to our country and personal experiences.
- A decorative and functional lid that connects to the story.
- Colours and glazing of the pot.

Students found guilty of **malpractice** which includes plagiarism will be awarded a **zero mark**. If a piece of work is incomplete at the time of submission, it should be submitted as is, and you will be given a mark on what has been completed.
