TASK DESCRIPTION

Specific task information as needed:

Part 1. Students need to read and perform of one of the plays set in class. The plays are:

- **The Hobbit**
- **Red Goes To Grandmas**
- **Friends**
- **Charlie and the Chocolate Factory**

Part 2. After workshopping the plays in class, students will design a poster advertising a production of the play to be performed at Mount Annan High School.

Part 3. Students will also need to design a costume for two different characters in the play. Focusing on design such as colour symbolism, texture and line.

Outcomes TO BE ASSESSED

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TASK SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS
