TASK DESCRIPTION / INSTRUCTIONS

Part 1. Visual Design Process Diary Elements and principles of Design

10 marks

You need to include a title page, study the practise of artist Kobi Levi and your own work sketches and ideas.

Part 2. Body of Work

25 marks

You will need to submit a body of work that includes the shoes created in class. This includes the following,

- 1. Clay Shoe- Create a Kobi Levi inspired shoe. Draw and design in your book and design in consultation with the teacher.)
- 2. Paper Shoe- Design your own show and build it with paper. CREATIVITY IS YOUR KEY!
- 3. Canvas shoe or drawing of a shoe- Create a design for canvas shoe based on an interest of your own (consultation with the teacher.)

OUTCOMES

- 5.1 develops autonomy in selecting and applying visual design conventions and procedures to make visual design artworks
- 5.2. makes visual design artworks informed by their understanding of the function of and relationships between artist artwork world audience
- 5.3 makes visual design artworks informed by an understanding of how the frames affect meaning

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FAILURE TO COMPLETE OR SUBMIT AN ASSESSMENT TASK

An outcome of your 'Misadventure Form' will be provided by the Deputy Principal.

Students found guilty of **malpractice** which includes plagiarism will be awarded a **zero mark**. If a piece of work is incomplete at the time of submission, it should be submitted as is, and you will be given a mark on what has been completed.
