### TASK DESCRIPTION / INSTRUCTIONS

#### TASK DESCRIPTION:

- Students will be required to complete **four** HSC-Style questions under examination conditions on the year 12 Ancient History 'Ancient Societies' unit of '**Spartan society to the Battle of Leuctra 371 BC**'.
  - The task will be completed during class time.
  - Students will be given **45 minutes** to complete this task.
  - **No notes or study notes** are to be brought into the exam.
- **Key areas for you to study include:**
- Everyday Life
  - Social structure, focusing on Helots and Inferiors.
  - Political organisation of Sparta
  - Economy of Sparta

#### QUESTIONS:

- The questions will be unseen.
- There will be **three** short answer questions, and **one** long answer response question.
- Students are expected to answer each question with reference to relevant sources and evidence, as well as their own prior knowledge to display a depth of knowledge of the topic.

### TASK SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Students will complete this task in class under exam conditions. Failure to abide by exam conditions will result in a zero mark.

### FAILURE TO COMPLETE OR SUBMIT AN ASSESSMENT TASK

If you do not attend school on the Due Date of an Assessment Task to submit or complete the task in person you will be given a zero mark unless you comply with the following Assessment Guidelines:

- For Assessment Task completed at home – you must submit the assessment task before school on the next day you attend.
- For Assessment Tasks completed at school – you must report to the relevant Head Teacher before school the next day you attend and discuss when you will complete task missed or a substitute task.
