#### **TASK DESCRIPTION / INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Sections to be completed:

2a) Create a nursery (online or model) - *Must include: A central theme, furniture, bedding, safety, hygiene, toys and clothing. - 15 Marks* 

**2b)** Information pamphlet/PPT - You must include: 1. a cost list of what each item would cost a family to buy, 2.

where it would be purchased from and 3. an overall total cost of your nursery. 5 Marks

3) Plan a baby shower (invite, games, menu ideas) - 15 Marks
